Fire Instructor I Manipulative Skills:

Please view the following link for information the forms and equipment a candidate must have available in order to participate in manipulative skills examination: <http://wyofire.state.wy.us/pdf/certificationinformation.pdf>.

State non accredited certificate: Candidates must pass the In-House Comprehensive Skills Test. Candidates are assessed for competency for each skill listed on the training record. Keep in mind this is a **test** and there should be **no coaching or training** during the testing process. If a candidate fails to perform a skill, it will count as a first attempt failure and they will be given a second attempt. If they fail a second time they need to be retrained on that skill and tested again. Only **qualified** candidates that have passed with **100%** should be allowed to take the State SPOT CHECK exam.

Candidates are required to give a minimum of a 15-minute presentation following the Checklist on page 8. Candidates are given two attempts if necessary to perform the 15-minute presentation. If they fail on the second try, then they have failed the examination. Candidates must wait **30 days** before the third and final attempt. Candidates taking third attempts will give one additional presentation. **No training, teaching, or coaching is allowed during this state test.**
